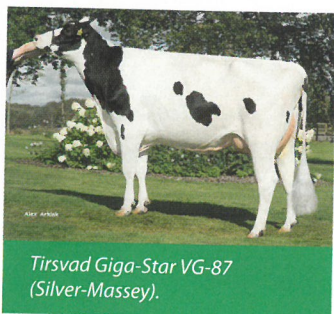


NEW ZEALAND

The South Island Show (New Zealand) was won by Belbrook Smokin Explosion from Belbrook Farming. The Reserve Senior was Cresslands Damion Lizy from Cresslands Farm, while Tahora High Octane Lovable owned by Dean Geddes captured the HM title.

DENMARK

Tirsvad Silver Giga-Star is the Cow of the Year in Denmark. Giga-Star was bred by Søren Ernst Madsen and is a successful bull dam, with sons like Holani-P, Gigastar (Gymnast), Gipsy, Match-P and Charles in Germany, and the Spanish Sniper son Gigastar. Her daughter Tirsvad Sniper Gambia VG-89 is the dam of Geysler-P (Italy), Hondo (Spain) and Hudson & Herning-P (Germany).

ALL-AMERICAN

In the American state of Pennsylvania, the All-American show was won by Macland-HF Yoder Rachel owned by Adam Liddle, ahead of Heart&Soul Sammy Ricki owned by Hayden Weaver. Triumphant for the Red Holsteins was Cherry-Lor Ladd Ripple-Red owned by Cael Hembury, ahead of Ms Avalanche Avon-Red owned by Jaycey Miller.

VG-88 SISTERS

At the farm of Matt & Joe Engel, Luck-E Holstein in Hampshire, Illinois (US), seven full sisters recently all scored VG-88 as two-year-olds. Another full sister, who was sold at a sale, also scored VG-88. The eight sisters are Doc daughters of Luck-E McGucci Afro-Red EX-94. Afro is a daughter of the 2020 Red Impact winner, Luck-E Advent Asia-RC EX-14 (Advent-Blitz).

FRANCE

The French event Sommet de l'Élevage was won by Sancy Diamondback Mahou owned by La Plaine/Gauthier. Becoming Reserve Grand was Verdel Golddust Nobelle from Earl Verdel, while the Beemer daughter BB Nelva owned by Besson-Bassignac became HM. A special prize was received by Bonanza from Earl Petit Ramard, with a lifetime production of nearly 150,000 kg/330,000 lb.

TOP GTPI

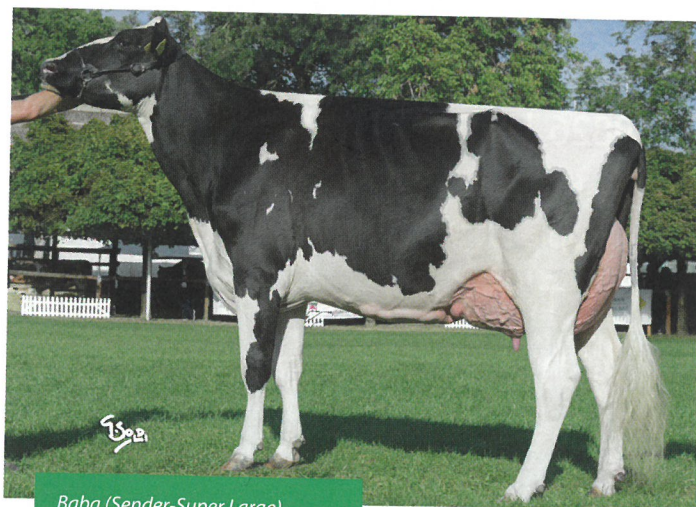
The American October release provided two bulls above 3130 gTPI; a Captain-Legacy from the offspring of Glo-Crest O-Man Pirate (with 3134 gTPI), and Cherrypencol Gameplan, a Gameday-Legacy from the offspring of Tiger-Lily Uno Leah (3133 gTPI). Elsewhere in this HI, read about the strong breeding Leah. Standing out among the female Holsteins is Genosource Dream Up, with 3165 gTPI. She is an Upside-Guzman from the line of Morningview Baxter D-Rae EX-92.

GERMANY

With 163 gRZG, Koepon Topshot Ruby captured the nr.9 position of all female Holsteins in Germany. A remarkable score, because Ruby is the only milking animal in the complete top-50. The Topshot daughter descends from Rubicon descendant Koepon Ruby Ann (Regenia family) and during the VOST Select Sale 2017 sold for €21,000 to Möller (RBB region).

HUNGARY

The National Hungarian show was won by the 4-year-old Baba, a daughter of EDG Sender (Mogul) out of a Super Large dam, owned by Agronómia. Italian judge Massimo Capra selected Baba's contemporary and Apprentice daughter Fonzi from Nemzeti Ménesbirtok Tangazdaság as Reserve Grand.

CLOPPENBURG – The highest price (€2600) at the sale in Cloppenburg (Germany) for a Fuel daughter of Hatke.

RENEGADE – In recent weeks, the Renegade sons Sandy-Valley Conway (from the Cosmopolitan family) and Siemers Parfect (from the offspring of Welcome Ozzie Peya) received the most registrations with Holstein USA. More about sire Renegade elsewhere in this HI.

LANDES – In the French department of Des Landes, Classic daughter Pebi-Over owned by Earl Peberot became Grand Champion.

SHIPPING – The Canadian Delaplaine Shipping, now with 80,000 kg/176,367 lb to her name, classified EX-95 (97 udder).

SWEDEN – The Swedish show Dalbokon was won by the young and beautifully uddered EH Sidekick Skeda, owned by EH Holsteins. The Reserve title went to Ståme Capital Gain Sidekick owned by Ståme Holsteins.

VERDEN – In Verden (Germany), the Batman son JEH Balou-PP sold for €3300, and an Axminster daughter from the Kasten herd for €2700.

LUXEMBOURG – The Holstein show in the Luxembourg Ettelbrück was won by Long-P daughter Dandy from Rising Star Holsteins. Other winners were the Jordy descendant Shooting Star from Antimonium Holstein and Yorick daughter Leane from Holstein Bosseler.

MOOVIN – At the sale in Fond du Lac (US), the highest price of \$5800 was paid for Jimtown Moovin Natasha.

STANLEYCUP – Jeanlu Stanleycup Alexis from Signature Holsteins won the Championship Show in Ontario/Quebec (Canada).

HAMM – During the monthly sale in Hamm (Germany), €2400 was paid for a Playboy daughter owned by Köster.

CONTROL – The show in the French Brienne-le-Château was won by the Control daughter Coum Naguna owned by Coumiere/Picasso.
